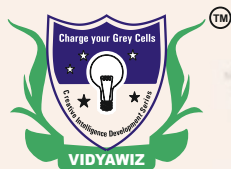

E.g., differentiating between ण / ष / स, and long vs short vowels

2. Fluency (प्रवाहितता)

Smoothness and flow of speech without unnecessary pauses

Confidence and natural rhythm while speaking

Criteria for assessment

3. Memorization & Recitation (स्मरणम्, / पाठ)
Accurate recitation of shlokas, Prathana
Correct meter (छन्दः) and intonation where applicable
4. Presentation & Confidence (आत्मविश्वासः / प्रस्तुति)
Posture, eye contact, and clarity
Confident delivery and respectful speech
5. Vocabulary (शब्दसम्पदा)
Use of appropriate and varied vocabulary
6. Comprehension & Response (बोधनशक्ति)
Understanding and responding accurately to questions.
Listening skills and relevance of answer.
